Friends,



Last night I got the terrible news that we've lost another beloved classmate, as she died far too young. There was some confusing/conflicting info for a few hours so I held off on sending out a notification. But now, it does appear to be confirmed that **Heather Hussey** died some time yesterday at her home.

As you know, this is our 3rd classmate that has passed at an age that you just don't expect to be losing peers. Heather was a mother, a friend to many of our classmates, and sister of another EA friend – Alvin (Al) Hussey. As of right now, I have not been able to obtain any information on funeral arrangements. If I'm able to get that information, I'll pass it along to the rest of the class. As for the cause/manner of death... I'm hearing too many confusing pieces of information to be able to provide any reliable info. However, it is my understanding that she had just recently returned from a prolonged hospital stay of about a month and was found yesterday by a young child approximately 8-10 years old (unknown if it was her child). The family is describing it as "medical complications" and one source reported that her mother mentioned a possible stroke. My apologies for the spotty information.

For those of you who are not aware, we do have a memorial page on our website called "[In Memoriam](#)". I will be posting something about Heather on that page at some point. Anybody is welcome to write a memorial on that page. You can do it by logging in and posting your thoughts. Or you can send them to me and I'd be glad to post it on your behalf. I haven't been close to Heather since 6th grade (she was actually my "girlfriend" for a while in Westinghouse). Our lives took different paths and we did not keep in touch. Some of you were closer to her and I'd love to hear from you so that we can post a fitting memorial & small tribute to her.

So once again as a united class, we stand together in prayer for the family & friends of an old friend. As a parent, I can't bear the thought of her kids having to go on without a mother. Life is much more fragile than we realize at times. And this is just one of the many reasons why I place so much value in staying in touch with all of you and making a strong effort to reconnect.
